

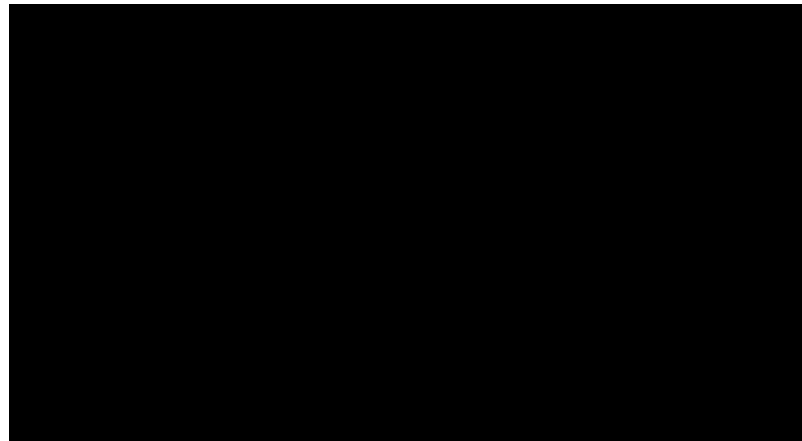
Dear Director of National Parks  
(CC Minister Frydenberg, Tony Burke MP),

In response to the draft management plans about cutbacks to National Park zone (IUCN II/ 'sanctuary') protection in Australia's marine parks network, I am extremely angry and shocked to learn that the Turnbull Government is going against last year's first round of consultation – where 54,000 people provided comment, the vast majority of which called for a **significant increase** in marine National Park zones, **not less**.

It is absolutely outrageous and downright embarrassing to have a government persistently disregarding the crucial protection of our land and marine ecosystems, when there is scientific evidence screaming at us to stop continual destruction of our natural environment.
